## Autumn Term 2025 Edmonton Green Nursery Newsletter

Dear Parents and Carers,

The team would like to take this opportunity to welcome you and your children to Nursery. We look forward to working together to support your child's development and extend their learning.

### **The Curriculum**

This term will focus on helping the children to settle in their new environment. The children will be spending their time getting to know the staff and each other. They will also be learning the expectations and routines of the school and classroom.

Our Topic for Autumn 1 is **Ourselves**. We will be looking at ourselves, our likes, dislikes, our families and friends. In Autumn 2, our topic will be **People Who Help Us** where we will learn about the different jobs and roles in our community and how they contribute to keeping us safe and healthy. We will be using all areas of the curriculum to cover topics and the children will learn new songs, poems, rhymes and stories.

### **Communication, Language and Literacy**

The children will learn how to communicate with their new friends and adults in the classroom. They will learn to recognise their name as part of our routines. They will also make marks and talk about what their marks mean.

### **Maths**

The children will explore counting small amounts and saying number names through singing songs such as *One, two, three, four, five. Once I caught a fish alive!* They will experiment with making marks that represent numbers. The children will also explore 2D and 3D shapes through creating pictures and models.

### **Other curriculum areas**

The children will learn about the season of Autumn. They will begin to think about how the weather changes in Autumn and how this feels to them. The children also begin to learn about the various festivals and celebrations that take place during this term, such as Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas.

### **Clothing**

Please ensure that your child has a spare set of clothes in a bag in school, which has their name in. As the weather turns colder, the children will need appropriate shoes and a warm coat for the outdoor area.

### **Sharing activities and achievements**

We would really like to see what the children do at home with you and activities they enjoy. You will be sent information about using Evidence Me, an app on your phone or tablet

which will allow you to share pictures and videos of your child with us and add to their learning journey. We will also be able to share activities they do through this.
